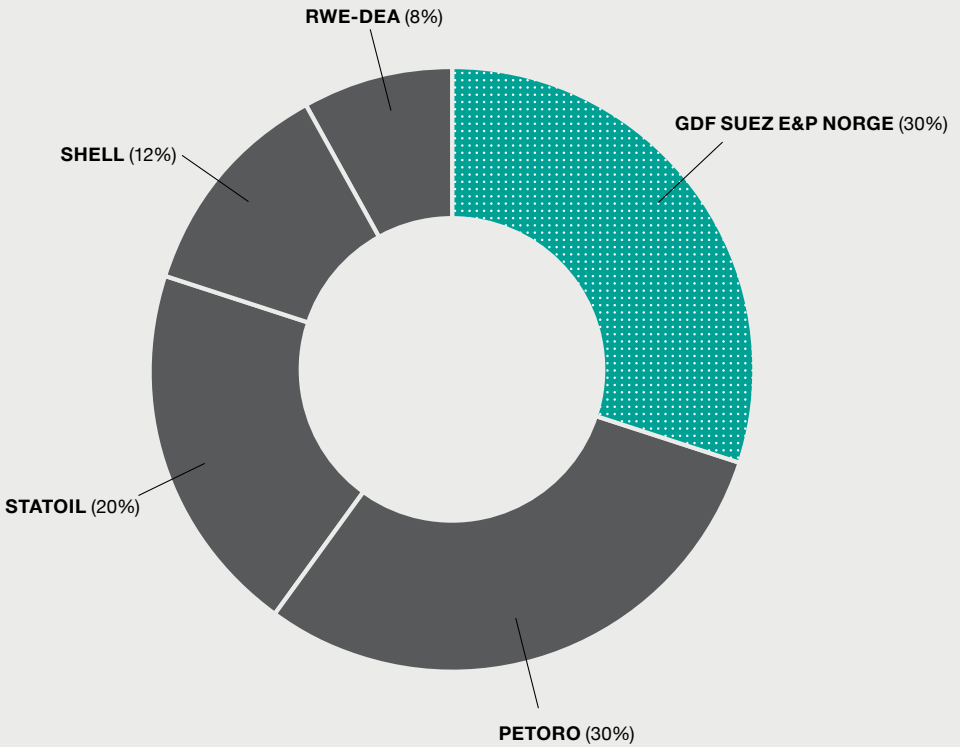

»» During the last quarter of 2010 GDF SUEZ E&P Norge will take over as operator of the Gjøa field, located in the North Sea, 60 km off the coast of Florø.

The opening of Gjøa is also the opening of a completely new petroleum area in the Northern North Sea. The Gjøa production facility provides many opportunities as a hub for the area, stimulating exploration activity and offering

processing and transport capacity, and will provide a tie-back solution for the Vega fields. Statoil has been operator during the development phase.

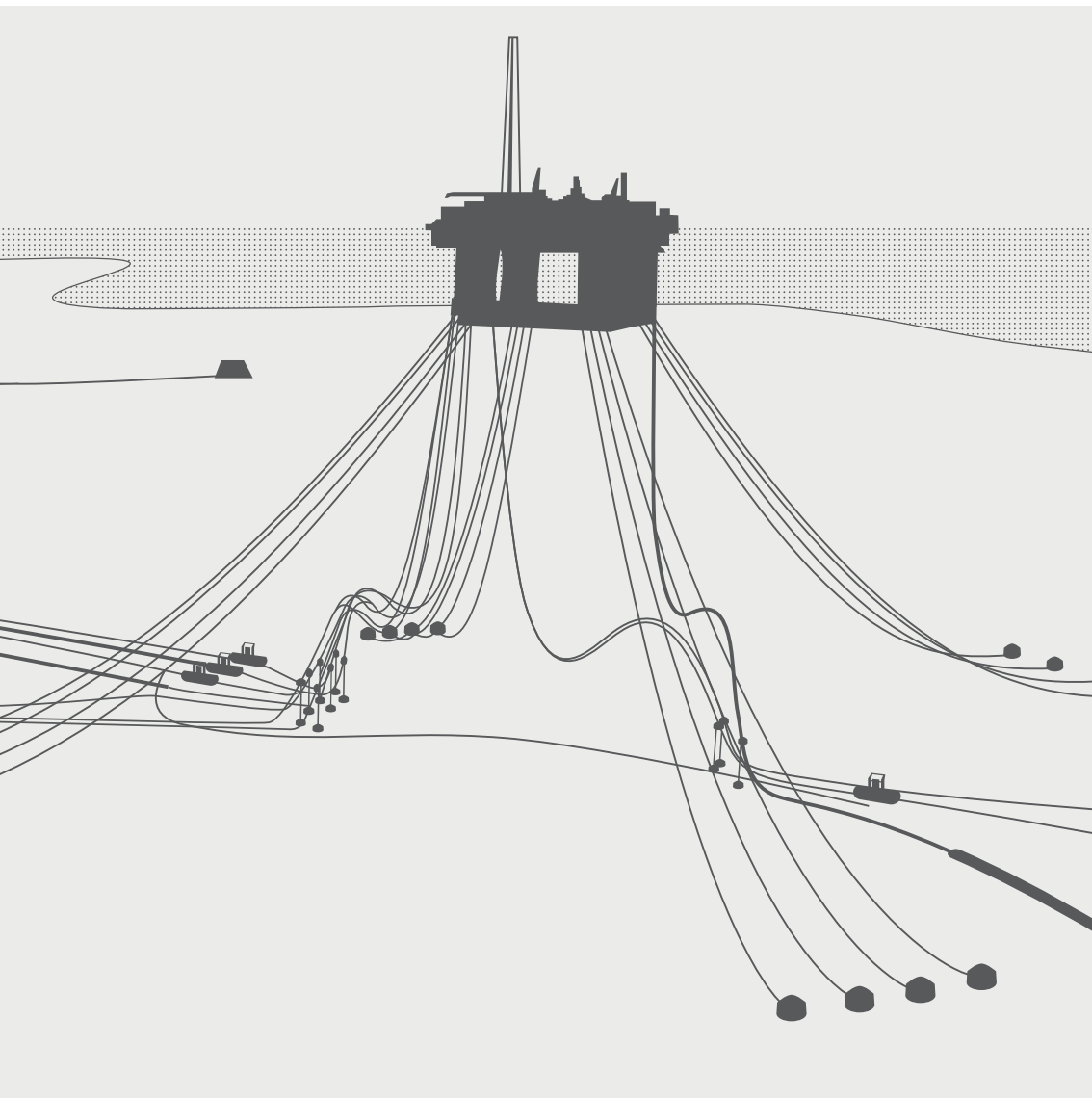

Gjøa is the company's first production operatorship on the Norwegian Continental Shelf, and a stepping stone for future operatorships. Gjøa will make use of the latest work processes and tools for Integrated Operations.



Electricity to the floating facility is provided from land, for the first time on the Norwegian Continental Shelf, saving annual CO₂ emissions equivalent to those produced by 100,000 cars.

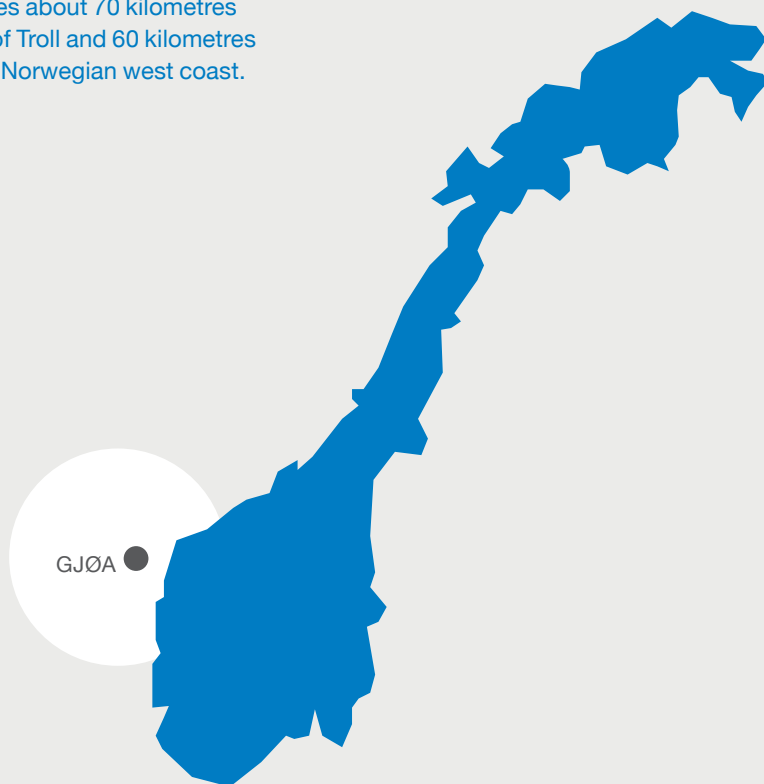

In Florø, GDF SUEZ E&P Norge has established its Gjølå base, from which the Gjølå platform will receive all necessary supplies.

Location

Gjøa lies about 70 kilometres north of Troll and 60 kilometres off the Norwegian west coast.
